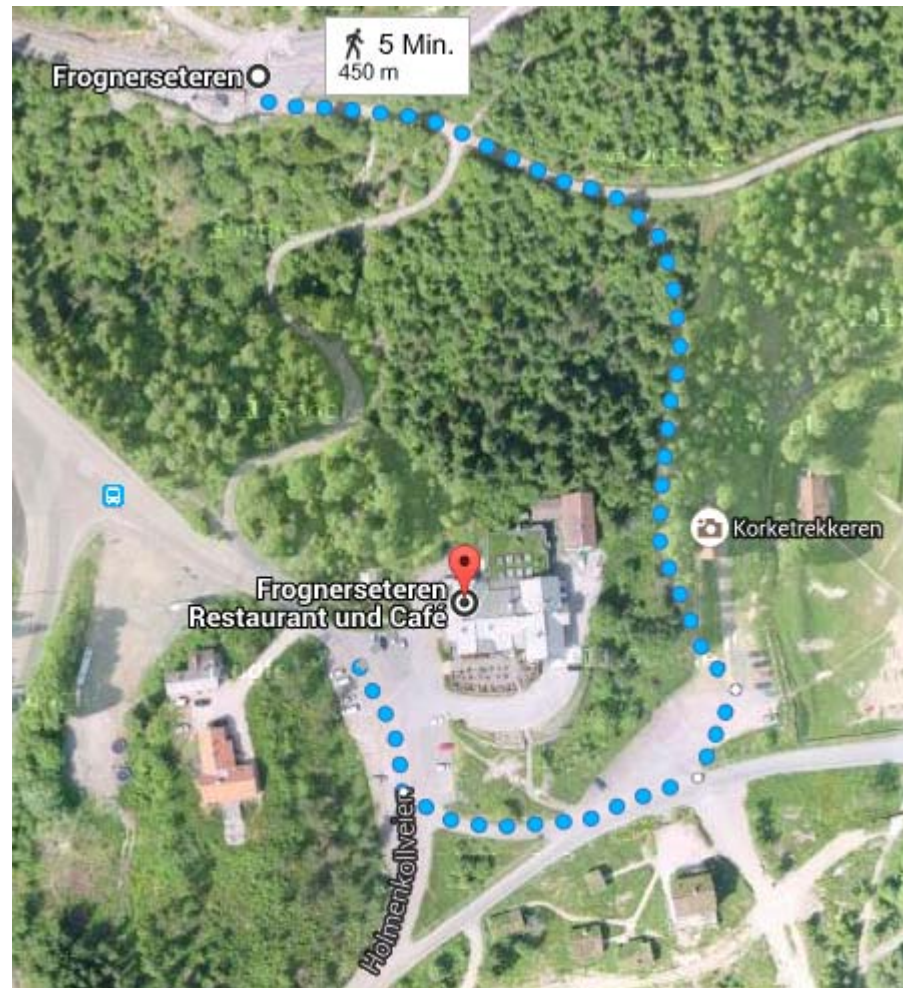


## VENUE
