appreciate if your collaborators and PhD students will also participate. As usual, the languages of the Symposium are English and German.

Publication: The presentations will be published together with those of the last symposium held in autumn 2023. The papers will be peer-reviewed. Accepted symposium papers will be published in book format. All authors will participate in the peer-review process reviewing at least two articles. This allows us to continue our book series.

Approx. Fees:

- Symposium registration fee for members and non-members is 160 €. It includes lunches, refreshments and for ordinary members the membership fee for 2024.
- Symposium registration fee for PhD students is 110 €.
- Cost of conference dinner is 60 € and
- the excursion fee will be available by the time of registration.

Please note: Participants who have to withdraw their participation later than one month before the conference will be charged with 80% of the full registration fee.

By mid of June 2024, detailed information about program, registration procedure, payment, excursion, accommodation etc. will be provided.

The final symposium's program will be available at the latest one month before the meeting. The Symposium will be combined with a General Assembly.
